### **Thunder Road Marathon November 15th**

This popular annual event involves numerous street and lane closures along the marathon route. Event organizers expect 9,000 participants. The marathon will begin on 4th Street between Graham Street and Mint Street at 7:45 a.m. It follows a course through the Dilworth, Myers Park, South End, Third Ward, Belmont, NoDa, Plaza-Midwood Commonwealth, Chantilly, Elizabeth, Second and Third Ward neighborhoods. The race will finish on Mint Street (between Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and Third Street) at 1:45 p.m.

### **Southpark Turkey Trot November 27th**

The one mile run begins at 8:30 a.m. on Morrison Boulevard. The 8K and 5K will follow. Event organizers expect 10,000 runners.
